



We trust that the residents of your community will enjoy Targa Newfoundland. See the map on the back of this notice for details of the route and schedule. Targa operates with the assistance of volunteers from your community. Please follow their instructions

TIMES TO NOTE

120 minutes before the start AN EARLY COURSE SET-UP VEHICLE with **YELLOW LIGHTS** operating will assist the Safety Marshals to bring the stage under Targa's control. **Local traffic will be permitted.**

20 minutes before the start THE ROAD CLOSE VEHICLE with **RED LIGHTS** and siren operating will enter the stage. **After this vehicle passes the road is closed to all vehicles and pedestrians.**

At the start THE COURSE SAFETY VEHICLE with **RED LIGHTS** operating will enter the stage at speed, doing a final check and acting as the first competitor on the stage.

The competing Targa cars will run at 30 second intervals for approximately one hour. It is possible to have delays between competitors.

Immediately after the last competition vehicle THE ROAD OPEN VEHICLE with **GREEN LIGHTS** operating will reopen the road to the public. **Do not walk or drive on the road until it is reopened.**

SAFE VIEWING

The first priority of TARGA officials and volunteers is to ensure the safety of everyone on the route.

OBEY THE SAFETY MARSHALS WEARING ORANGE OR YELLOW TARGA VESTS.

DO NOT stand in RED TAPED areas.... THEY ARE DANGEROUS

DO NOT under any circumstances cross the road during the event.

Stand only behind the YELLOW TAPED areas. They are set out so you can watch safely.

Supervise all children very closely. Ensure they are supervised by an adult.

Control all pets. Place them inside a safe area for the event.

Do not park vehicles on the Targa route. Park them as far away from the route as possible.

Please bring these guidelines as a Safety Reminder when attending Targa!
